# ABOUT THE ÉCOLE DE CIRQUE DE BRUXELLES

#### 1- Get to know us!

For over 40 years, the Ecole de Cirque de Bruxelles has developed its own methodology and pedagogy for the circus arts. We believe that the circus arts can be used as a tool for education, teaching and integration. Circus workshops are given to around 1,000 students a week: children, teenagers and adults, with or without disabilities, from disadvantaged or more privileged neighbourhoods.

In addition to these weekly workshops, we run a number of pedagogical and artistic projects:

- The Handicirque sector: we have developed an inclusive approach to circus adapted to work with people with disabilities:
- Cirque Social: we run social cohesion projects using circus arts for the public in the Quartier Maritime area where we are based;
- Creation Workshops: our young circus enthusiasts specialise in the technique of their choice and meet every week to create a collective show:
- Pedagogical Training: for one year full-time, 14 students acquire a complete set of pedagogical skills, as well as an in-depth knowledge of the art of the circus, in order to become circus trainers;
- The Centre Européen de Funambulisme: we teach everyone the art of walking on a wire using a balancing pole, and offer local and European training courses and performances.

Since 2011, we have welcomed several European volunteers each year as part of the European Solidarity Corps. For 12 months, they take part in the life of the school and become an integral part of the team.

Each project is built around the expertise and expectations of the volunteers, in line with our proposals. The project will evolve over the year, and each experience is unique and individual.

# For this year 2025-2026, we are looking for 2 volunteers:

**Circus arts pedagogy**: The volunteer should have a circus background and enjoy working with children. You will be part of the pedagogical sector, supporting the trainers during circus workshops and activities.

**The school events**: The volunteer will support the external coordinator in organising the school's events (Open Days, Chapitô FP, Cabaret des Ateliers de Création, etc.), and one-off projects. You will support and take part in the day-to-day activities of the school, and should feel comfortable with having some office time.

The activities we propose are the basis on which each volunteer builds his/her own experience. The activities can be mixed and matched, and you will have the opportunity to discover all aspects of the School during your time with us.

We also encourage initiative and new ideas! If you wish, we will help you to develop your own personal project.

## How does it work?

- We help you find accommodation when you arrive, and we pay for the rent.
- We give you a monthly allowance to cover your food, local transport costs and pocket money.
- We pay for your travel to and from Brussels, and any expenses relating to visa fees.
- You will be covered by HENNER's European complementary insurance.
- You will have unlimited access to the free OLS language support platform, to perfect your French or any other language of your choice.
